# Purpose of the JCHC

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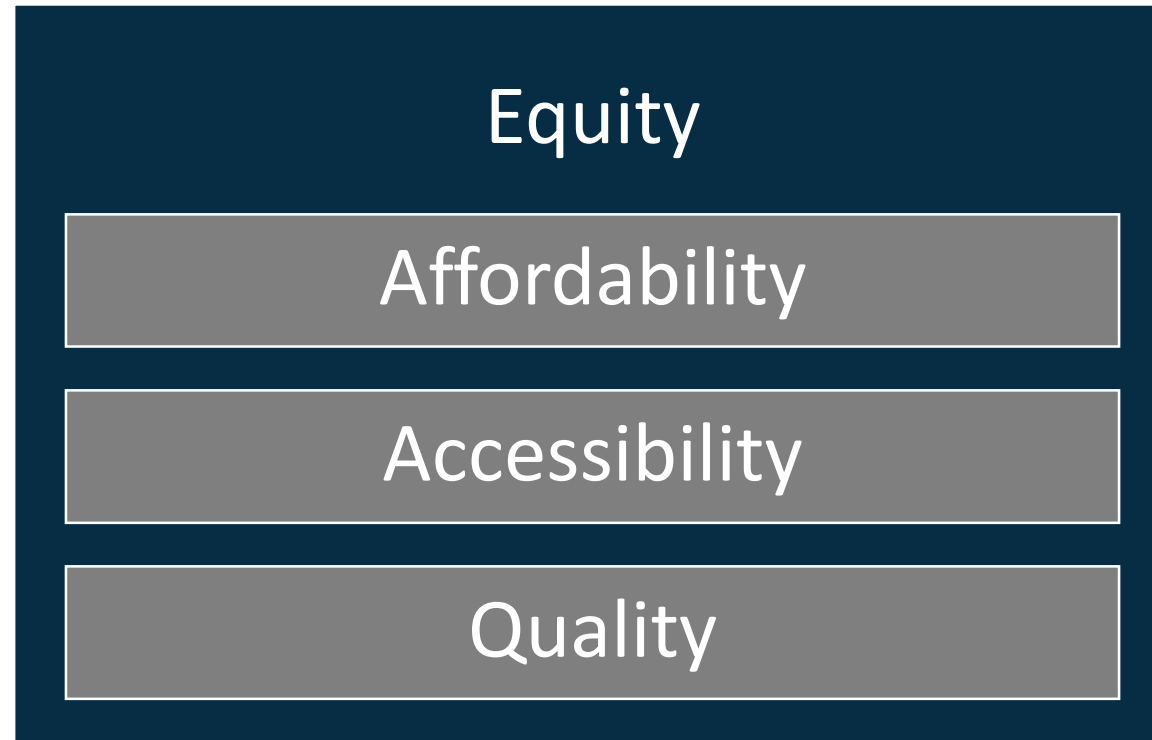
*“The purpose of the Commission is to study, report and make recommendations on all areas of health care provision, regulation, insurance, liability, licensing, and delivery of services.”*

# JCHC Strategic Objectives

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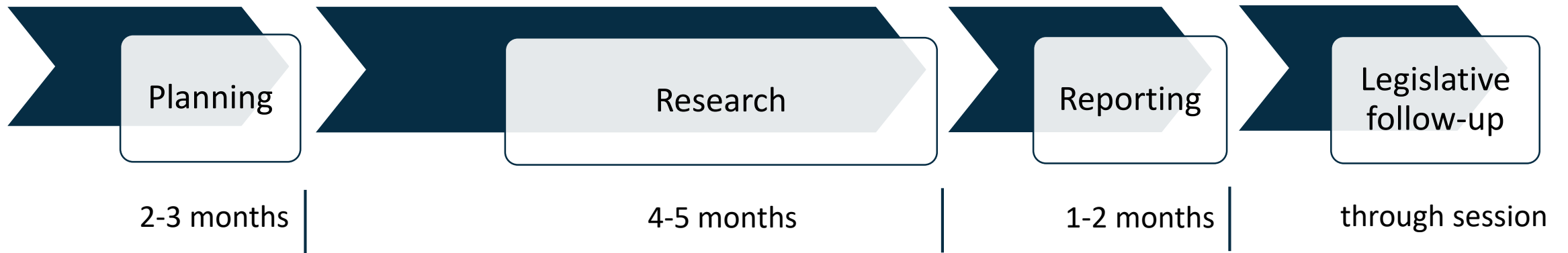


# JCHC addresses priority topics through studies and Commission recommendations

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- JCHC Members direct staff to research policy issues
- Staff conduct independent research and report conclusions and policy options to Members
- Members vote to recommend policy options for legislative action

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# JCHC study selection process

<b>September</b>	Solicit initial input from Members on potential 2022 study topics	✓
<b>October</b>	Executive subcommittee reviews potential studies and narrows the list to the top priorities	✓
<b>November</b>	Draft study resolutions provided to Members after JCHC meeting	✓
<b>Nov-Dec</b>	Members polled on their highest priority studies (ranked choice)	✓
<b>December</b>	Voting results provided to Members for formal approval of highest priority study resolutions	✓
<b>April</b>	Members review and reassess study priorities in light of topics referred during session	

# Members directed four studies for 2022

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- Affordability and accessibility of assisted living facilities
- Reducing unnecessary ED utilization
- Structure and financing of local health departments
- Provider data sharing to improve quality

# Six topics referred during sessions

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- Local health department structure, financing, and COVID lessons learned
- Oversight of vertically integrated insurance carriers
- Medicaid coverage for services addressing social determinants of health
- Addressing eating disorders
- Prescription drug price benchmarking
- Coverage for obesity services in Medicaid
