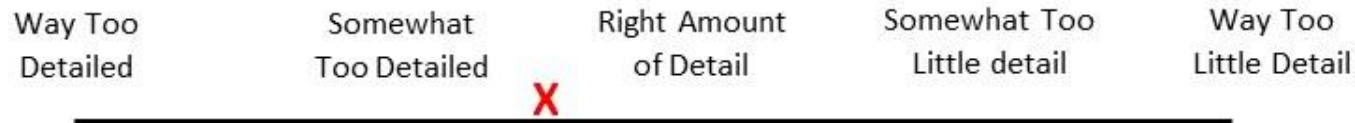

# Background

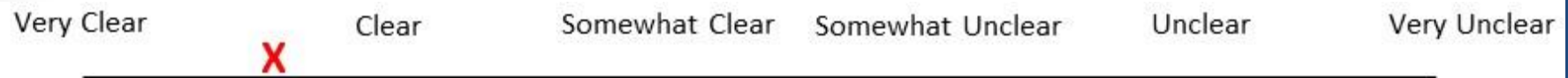
- Survey of JCHC members conducted in April – May, 2017 to receive feedback on staff studies

# Member Assessments of 2016 Staff Studies

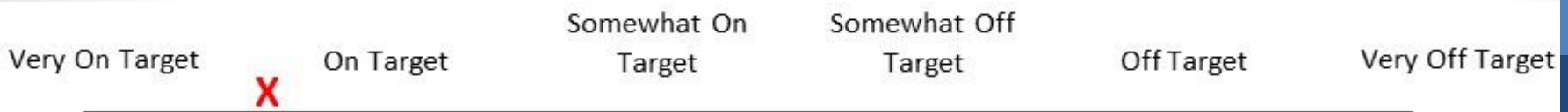
- Depth of Content:

- Alignment with study mandate:

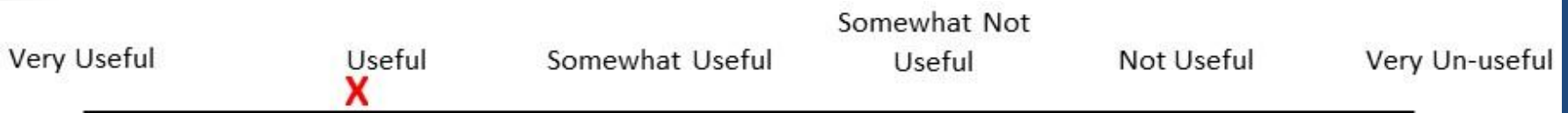


# Member Assessments of 2016 Staff Studies
