Addressing Rising Health Insurance Premiums in Virginia (October) >SI 49 (Senator Deeds) directs the JCHC to identify options to address rising premiums for health benefit plans sold in the Commonwealth > Tabled in Senate Rules Committee with an agreement that it would be considered by the JCHC > In conducting the study, JCHC shall: > Identify the extent to which premiums for private health benefit plans subject to Title 38.2 of the Code of Virginia in the individual, small group, and large group markets have increased over the past decade > Determine the causes driving such increases > Attempt to predict increases in the premiums for such health benefit plans over the next decade > Compare the increases of premiums for such health benefit plans in the Commonwealth to such increases in other states > Identify legislative and regulatory actions by other states that have been effective in reducing, or tempering the rate of increase in, the premiums for such health benefit plans




