**Call to Order**

Senator Barker called the Subcommittee meeting to order and introduced the first presenter Kathy Wilbberly.

**Telehealth Pilot Program**

Kathy Wilbberly began by introducing the two-year pilot project for Telehealth services. She listed 5 core elements needed for the success of the project such as the stakeholders, patient care teams, technology and processes for assistance. She also discussed the results of a survey that was taken between nurse practitioners and physicians and the challenges that are currently present with the collaborative relationships between the two groups.

**DD Waivers Update**

Dawn Traver’s presentation began with a description of the three types of waivers available to individuals with disabilities in the Commonwealth. She then gave an update on numbers of waivers that are currently in effect as well as the number of individuals on the waiting list. She spoke about a new program for shared living and what it entails. She also presented percentages of distribution per levels of need of the individuals. She explained that the higher levels are tiered and paid at the same rate. She then talked about the 6 types of living situations and the supports packages that go with each one. She concluded by presenting the

numbers of individuals who receive three new waiver services for private nursing, community coaching and community engagement.
