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### Call to Order

Delegate Christopher P. Stolle, Co-chair of the BHC Subcommittee called the meeting to order and recognized Ms. Snead who provided an overview of the agenda. Ms. Snead also discussed significant points made in Richard Bonnie's letter concerning SB 372 (Senator Barker) which would have required a mental health services plan for community colleges.

JCHC staff presented two studies:

Jaime H. Hoyle's study, *Mandatory Outpatient Treatment for Chronic Substance Abuse Disorder*, is a follow-up to the 2011 study requested in HJR 682 (Delegate O'Bannon). Three policy options were offered for public comment.

Dr. Michele L. Chesser's study, *Potential Expansion of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program* examined statutory changes as proposed in SB 634 (Senator Vogel) and HB 1289 (Delegate Jones). Dr. Chesser presented four policy options for public comment.
