Call to order and welcoming comments – Senator Barker

Roll Call - Agnes Dymora

Acting Executive Director Jen Piver-Renna gave a presentation on the Team-based Care Approaches to Improve Health Outcomes study. She briefed members on the impact of team-based care on patient health outcomes and the value of integrating pharmacists and behavioral health specialists into practice teams. She also highlighted primary care workforce shortages and resources required to sustain a team-based care practice. Lastly, she addressed Member questions.

Associate Health Policy Analyst Kyu Kang presented on the Vertically Integrated Carriers and Providers study. She informed the members about what the vertically integrated carriers and providers look like in Virginia as well as their impact on access, cost, and quality of care. Ms. Kang also addressed member questions.
